This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a final environmental assessment (EA) for the proposed FM 1171 project, and that the final EA is available for public review. The proposed project would construct a new location non-freeway roadway of FM 1171 from West of FM 156 to I-35W in Denton County, Texas.

The approved final EA is on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Dallas District Office, 4777 E. U.S. Highway 80, Mesquite, TX 75150, or call (214) 320-6100. It is also available online at [www.keepitmovingdallas.com/FM1171](http://www.keepitmovingdallas.com/FM1171).

Pursuant to 23 CFR 771.119(h), TxDOT will issue a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for this project no sooner than 30 days after the issuance of this notice of availability.
