The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is conducting a feasibility study for improvements to Northwest Highway (Loop 12) from Inwood Road to Hillcrest Avenue in Dallas County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an on-line virtual public meeting on the proposed project. The virtual meeting will be held on Monday, Dec. 7, 2020 beginning at 6 p.m. The virtual public meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation explaining the proposed project, which includes both audio and video components, along with other exhibits and materials for your review. **The virtual public meeting materials will be posted to www.KeepItMovingDallas.com/northwesthighway/publicmeeting on Monday Dec. 7, 2020 and will remain available online through the comment period deadline of Tuesday, Dec. 22, 2020.** If you do not have internet access, you may call (214) 320-4469 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process. Comments may be provided by mail, email or voicemail as explained below. **Please note that the materials will not be available until Dec. 7, 2020.**

The purpose of the Northwest Highway (Loop 12) Feasibility Study is to develop and analyze conceptual alternatives for Northwest Highway (Loop 12). Attendees will be able to learn about the study process and provide input on the future of Northwest Highway (Loop 12).

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you.
