



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
United States Highway (US) 377
From US 380 to North of BUS 377E
Denton County, Texas
CSJ: 0081-06-040**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen approximately 13.74 miles of United States Highway (US) 377 from US 380 to North of BUS 377E in Denton County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a Public Meeting on the proposed project. The meeting will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on **Thursday, April 16, 2020** at **Midway Church, 9540 US HWY 377, Pilot Point, TX 76258**. The meeting will be an Open House format with no formal presentation.

The purpose of the meeting is to present the planned improvements and to receive public comment on the proposed project. Representative from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project.

The proposed project consists of the reconstruction and widening of US 377 from US 380 in Cross Roads to North of BUS 377E in Pilot Point. Improvements would include the expansion of the current 2-lane rural roadway to a 6-lane urban roadway with a raised median to provide additional capacity and improve safety. Improvements would consist of 12-foot-wide travel lanes, 14-foot-wide outside shared-use lanes, and 5-foot sidewalks with American Disabilities Act (ADA) curb ramps in both directions through most of the project. Proposed drainage would be conveyed by curb & gutter, a storm sewer system and crossing culverts. Other improvements would include realigning the intersections of BUS 377 S at US 377, and FM 424 at US 377. The existing right of way (ROW) width would increase with the proposed project to 140-feet. The proposed project is anticipated to require 63.2 acres of additional ROW and 1.8 acres of proposed permanent drainage easements to accommodate the proposed improvements.

Maps showing the proposed project's location and the preliminary geometric design will be available for viewing at the public meeting. This information will also be on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Dallas District Office, 4777 E. Highway 80, Mesquite, TX 75150. Project information will also be available online at www.keepitmovingdallas.com under Upcoming Public Hearing/Meeting.

All interested persons are invited to attend this Public Meeting. Written comments from the public are requested and will be accepted for a period of 15 calendar days following the meeting. Written comments may be submitted either in person at the public meeting, by mail to the TxDOT Dallas District Office, Attention: Nelson Underwood, P.E., 4777 E. Highway 80, Mesquite, TX 75150-6643, or by email addressed to Nelson.Underwood@txdot.gov. **Written comments must be postmarked before Friday, May 1, 2020 to be included in the documentation of the public meeting.**

The public meeting will be conducted in English.
