The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is conducting a feasibility study for improvements to US 380 from I-35 to the Collin County Line in Denton County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting in-person and virtual public meetings to receive public comments on the proposed project. All meetings will present the same information, and the in-person meetings will be held in an open house format. Representatives from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project improvements. The meeting dates, times, and locations are listed below.

In addition to two in-person public meetings, TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project. The virtual public meeting can be viewed beginning Tuesday, Nov. 30, 2021 at 6 p.m. The virtual public meeting is not a live event and the materials can be viewed at your convenience. The virtual public meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation explaining the proposed project, which includes both audio and video components, along with other exhibits and materials for your review. The virtual public meeting materials will be posted to www.keepitmovingdallas.com/US380DentonPM3 on Tuesday, Nov. 30, 2021 and will remain available online through the comment period deadline of Wednesday, Dec. 15, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call (214) 320-4469 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process. Comments may be provided by mail, email, or voicemail as explained below. Please note that the materials will not be available until Tuesday, Nov. 30, 2021 at 6 p.m.

The purpose of the study is to analyze potential roadway options for US 380 in Denton County, including improving the existing alignment or utilizing new alignments. The recommended alignment for this study will be presented.

All interested persons are invited to attend either of the in-person public meetings or view the virtual public meeting online. All comments must be received or postmarked on or before Wednesday, Dec. 15, 2021 to be included in the documentation of the public meeting.

The public meetings, virtual and in-person, will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
