

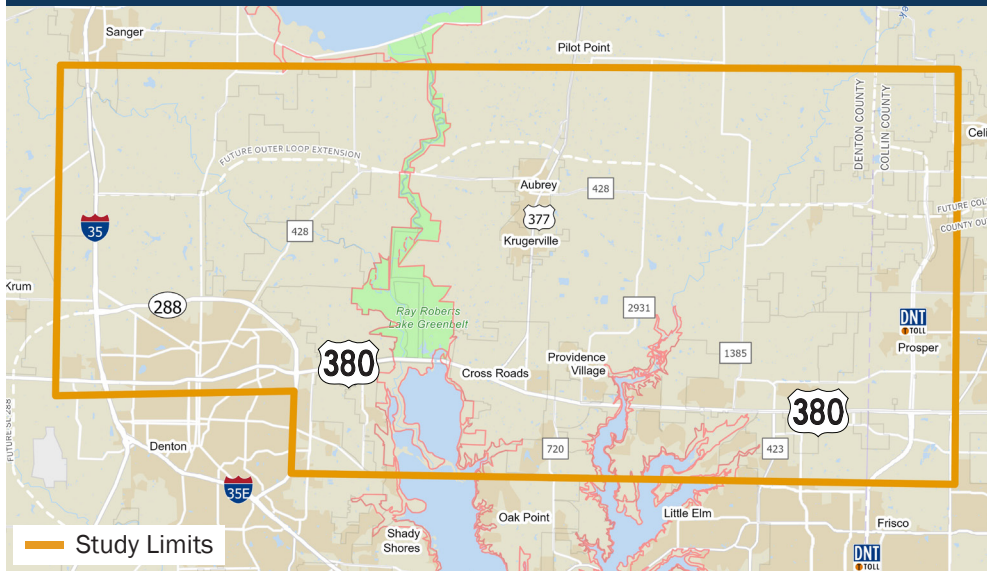


JOIN US FOR A VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING
