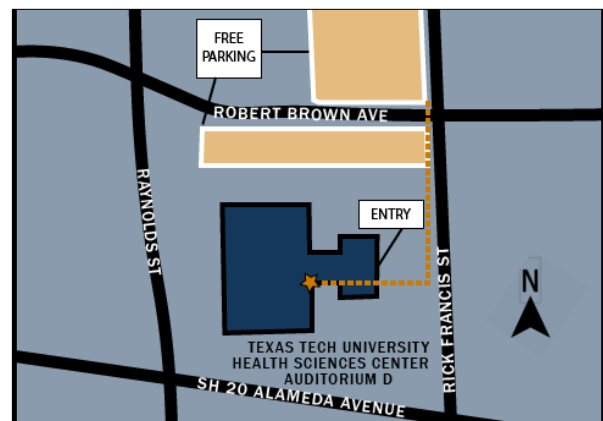
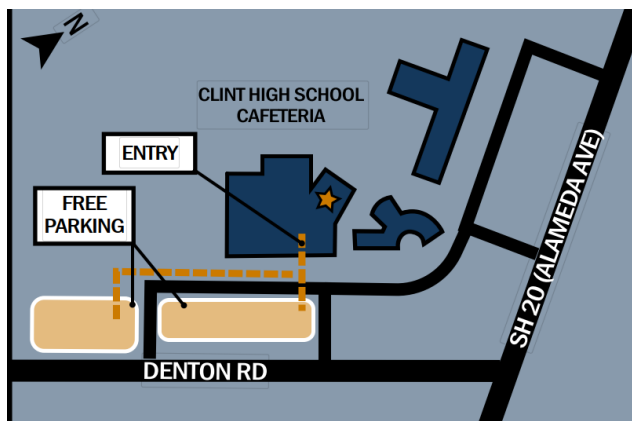

Join the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the third and final series of Public Meetings to learn about and participate in the development of the SH 20 (Alameda Avenue) Corridor Study. The Corridor Study will document the communities' vision for SH 20 (Texas/Alameda/Main) as it relates to future transportation along the corridor through 2040. The Corridor is a 35-mile section of SH 20 (Texas/Alameda/Main) from SH 20 (Mesa Street) in El Paso to Shaffer Road in Tornillo.

Two **Public Meetings** with a virtual public meeting option will be conducted at the times and locations above. The same content will be presented at both meetings in English. The virtual public meeting voiceover will be available in both English and Spanish. The study team is seeking additional feedback from the public from June 15th, 2022, to July 1st, 2022, on the design and operational recommendations for the corridor.

If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you.
