PROJECT DESCRIPTION

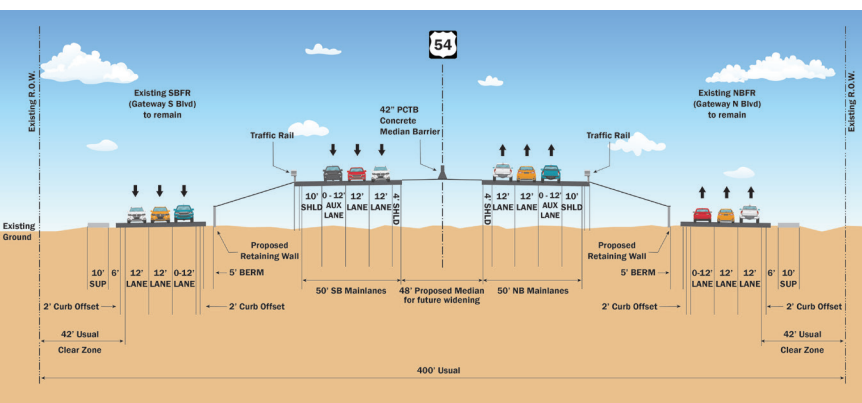
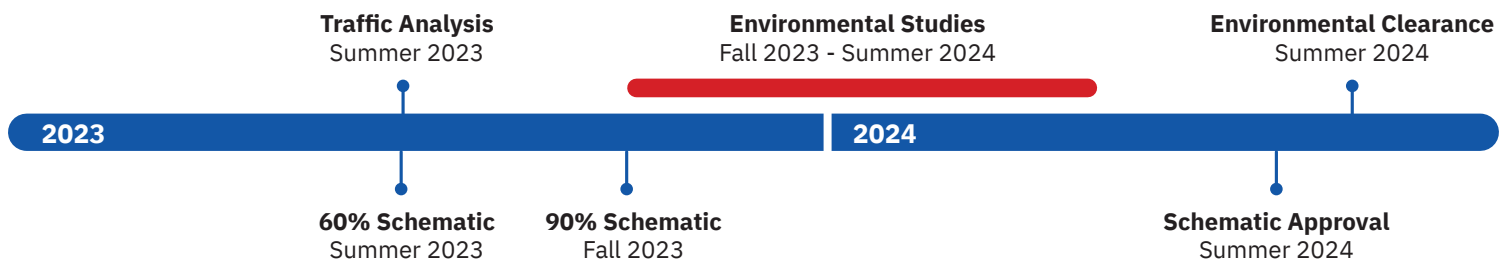
The US 54 (Patriot Freeway) Improvements project extends approximately 2.3 miles starting just north of Kenworthy Street and terminating just north of McCombs Street (FM 2529). This project will improve capacity, pedestrian accommodations, traffic circulation, access and safety within a corridor experiencing rapid growth and increased traffic.

PROJECT GOALS

This project includes the following improvements:

- Extend 2~12 ft. lanes and 4 ft. inside shoulders and 10 ft. outside shoulders with flush median to accommodate future main lanes and shoulders
- Provide a new US 54 overpass at Sean Haggerty Drive and McCombs Street (FM 2529)
- Provide and accommodate x-ramp configurations and auxiliary lanes along the mainlanes and existing frontage roads
- Provide continuous shared-use paths from Kenworthy Street to McCombs Street (FM 2529)
