FACT SHEET

Introduction

Welcome and thank you for attending the 2022 public hearing for the Fort Worth District to present its transportation projects, programs, and policies affecting bicycle use on the state highway system.

These roadways include Interstate and State highways with frontage roads and/or shoulders allowing for bicycling activities and Farm-to-Market or Ranch-to-Market roads, defined as a state highway or county road that connects rural or agricultural areas to market towns.

TxDOT Policies

TxDOT design guidelines for bicycle and pedestrian facilities were updated in May 2022 and include guidance for Urban, Urban Core, Suburban, and Rural Towns for new construction, reconstruction, or widening projects and projects involving bridge replacement, bridge deck replacement, or bridge rehabilitation.

Projects

- **1st Street from East 4th Street to Haltom Road**
 - Bike lanes, sidewalks, and a shared use path
 - 0.82 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2025
- **4th Street from North I-35W to East 1st Street**
 - Bike lanes, sidewalks, and a shared use path
 - 1.27 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2025
- **The Centreport Trail**
 - 12-foot-wide shared use path along the existing road, sidewalks, shared use path
 - 1.34 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2026
- **SH 180 from Cooper Street to Collins Street in Arlington**
 - Sidewalks along Division Street
 - 0.99 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2027
- **Bomber Spur Trail**
 - Shared use path that includes a trail bridge
 - 0.84 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2028
