PROJECT OVERVIEW

Highway/Limits: Center Street (Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive) From East Bardin Road to Southeast Green Oaks Boulevard
Arlington, Tarrant County

Project ID: 0902-90-228

Project Length: Approximately 1.18 mile of Center Street (Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive) plus the East Emburcrest Drive connection.

Description: The proposed project would connect Center Street (Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive) from East Bardin Road to Engleside Drive, with pavement markings carrying through to Southeast Green Oaks Boulevard. The new roadway would consist of four lanes, including two northbound lanes and two southbound lanes, separated by a raised median. Additionally, East Emburcrest Drive would be connected to the new roadway with one eastbound and one westbound lane.

Construction Cost: The proposed project would have an estimated construction cost of approximately \$10,000,000.

Right of Way: The project would require approximately 8.56 acres of additional right-of-way, all of which are owned by the City of Arlington. The project would also require approximately 4.43 acres of permanent easements.
