Rural Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP)

THE RURAL TIP

includes both grouped projects and individually listed projects that include added-capacity projects and regionally significant projects to be funded outside of MPO boundary, and within a TxDOT district during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding.

It can include projects for:



A Rural TIP project is anticipated to be funded within the next 4 years.

It shows regional agreement (community-region-state) on the need of a project.



Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)

THE STIP

A statewide prioritized listing/program of transportation projects covering a period of four years (2027 – 2030) that is consistent with the long-range statewide transportation plan (TTP), metropolitan transportation plans (MTPs), and transportation improvement programs (TIPs) for both urban and rural areas and is **required** for projects to be eligible for funding under title 23 U.S.C. and title 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53.

The upcoming STIP will cover the period of fiscal years 2027 – 2030 and should be approved by the Federal Highway Administration by late summer 2026.



How the Rural TIP Impacts You

The Rural TIP process includes opportunities to provide input on the priority of major projects that are listed on it.

Local and small projects around your community dealing with safety and access also get funding through the Rural TIP, for example:

- Road expansions
- Sidewalks
- Bike lanes
- Pavement repair or maintenance
- New or improved signals
- Turning lanes

The Rural TIP is a fiscally constrained list of projects that functions as a budgeting tool for our district. Funds can come from:

- **Federal Government**
 - **Majority through** the Federal Highway and Transit Administrations
- **State**
 - **Majority through TxDOT's** Unified Transportation Program funding categories
- **Region**
- **Local**

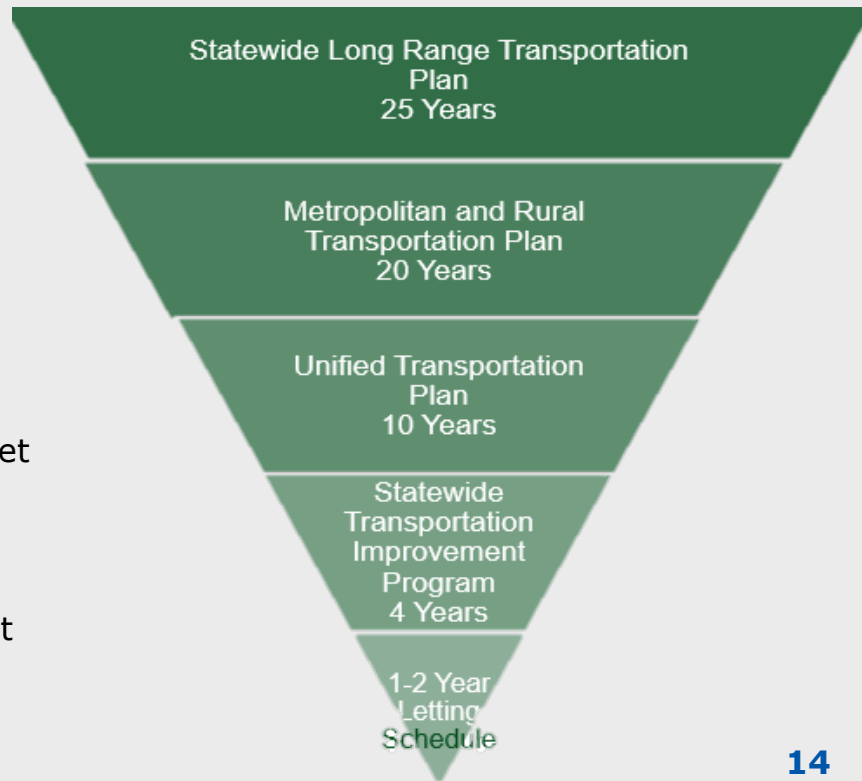

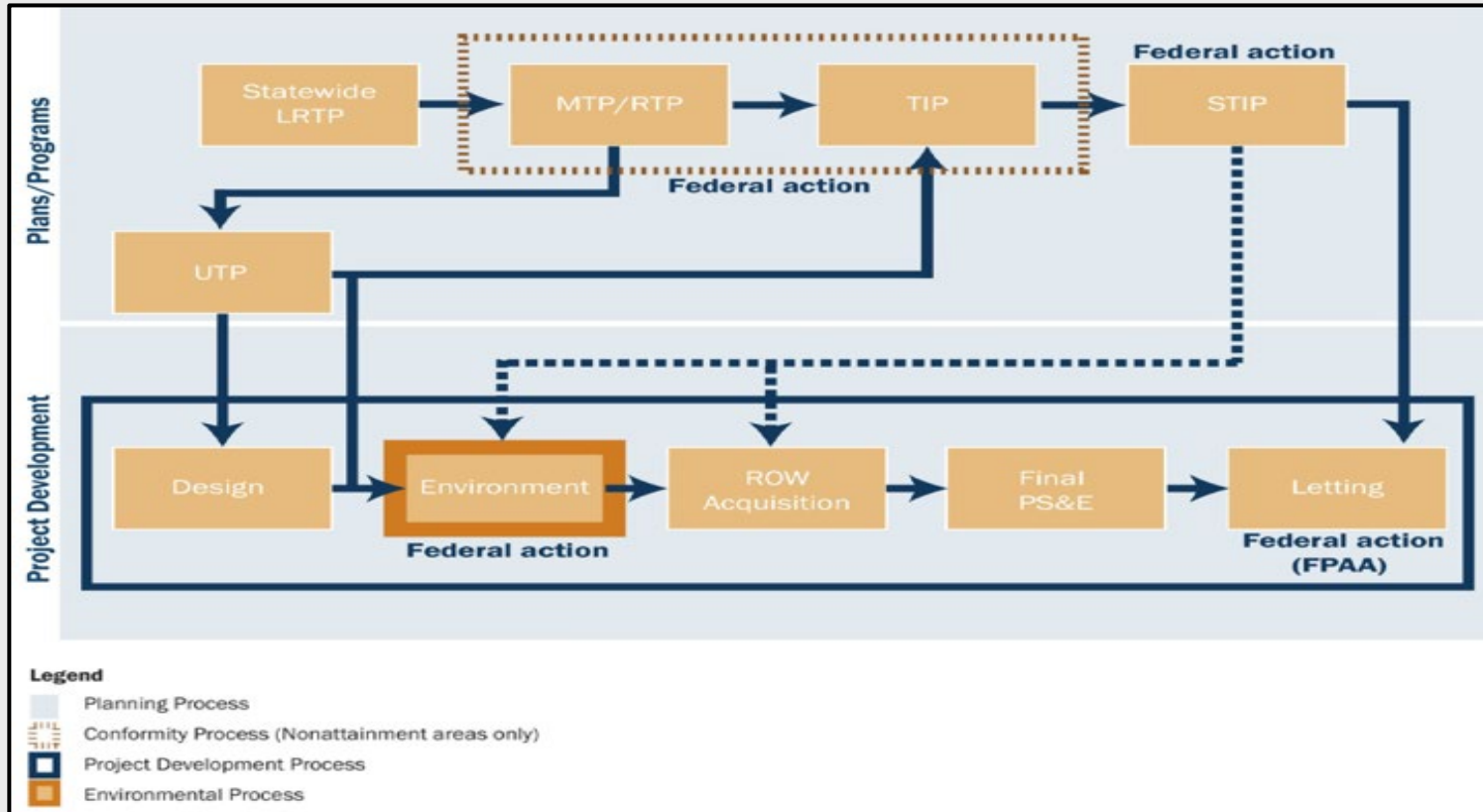

 - 4 yr. program of funded multimodal projects consistent with the long-range plan
 - Metropolitan TIP
 - Rural TIP

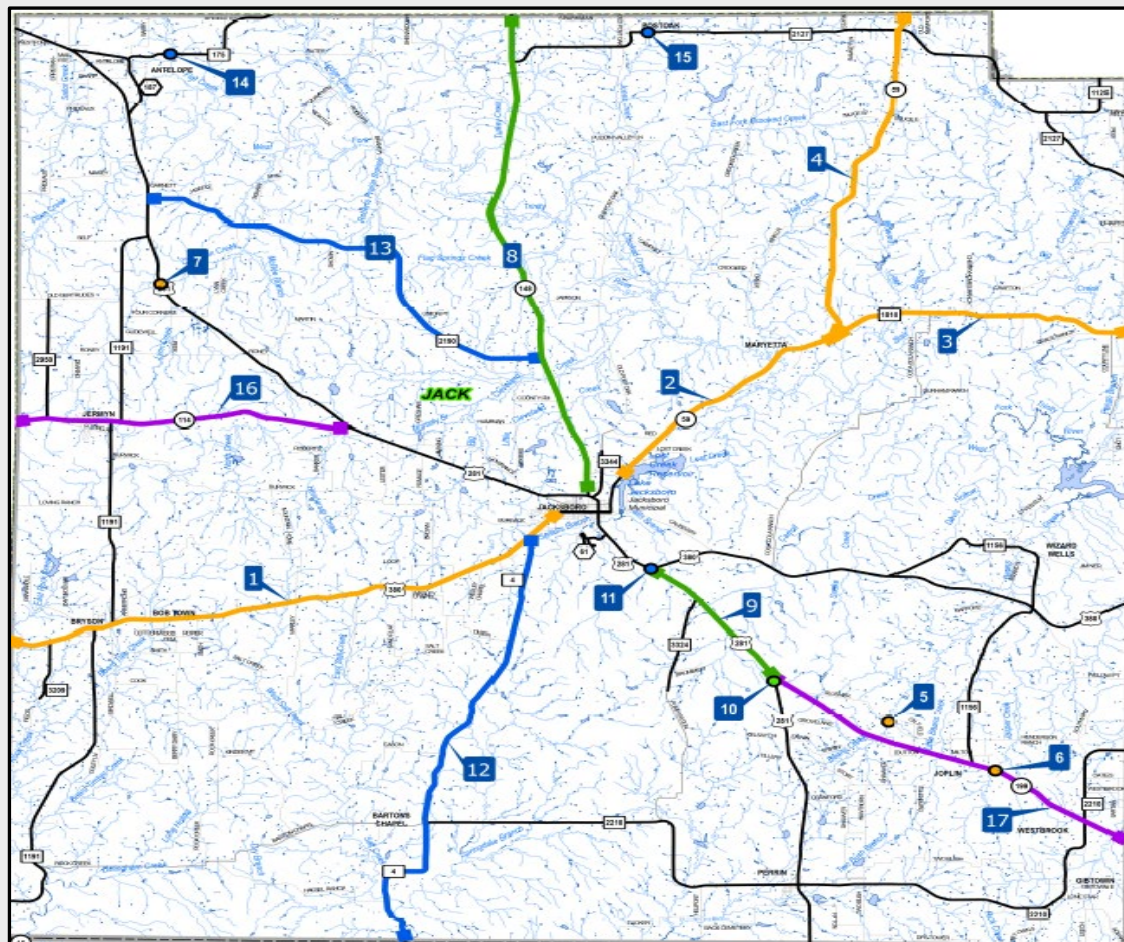
