

FM 917 IMPROVEMENTS

PROJECT OVERVIEW

HIGHWAY/LIMITS: Farm to Market (FM) 917: from west of Avenue F to east of SH 174, Johnson County

PROJECT ID: 1181-02-033, 1181-03-036

PROJECT LENGTH: Approximately 0.623 miles

DESCRIPTION: The project includes the realignment of FM 917 in downtown Joshua extending from just west of Avenue F eastward to east of SH 174. The proposed project includes replacement of an at-grade BNSF railroad crossing with a railroad grade separation (underpass) along with realigning and widening FM 917 from the existing two-lane section to a three-lane section with curb and gutter. The project would also include enhancements to accommodate bicycles and pedestrians. The purpose of the proposed project is to enhance safety and connectivity within the downtown Joshua area.

CONSTRUCTION COST: \$13.2 million (estimated)

RIGHT-OF-WAY: Approximately 6.71 acres

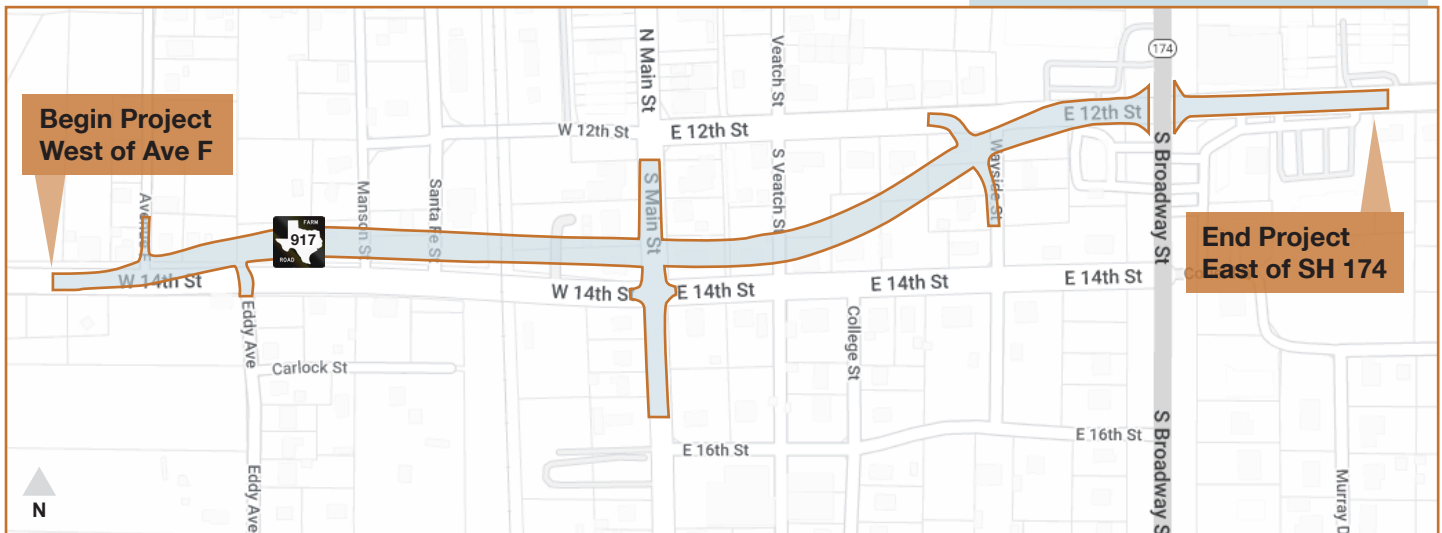
