The Texas Department of Transportation Fort Worth District is proposing the reconstruction and widening of approximately 3.6 miles of FM 1187 from west of Chisholm Trail Parkway to McCart Avenue in Tarrant County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public hearing on the proposed project with an in-person option.

**The virtual hearing will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation and other hearing materials will be posted online by Tuesday, October 15, 2024, at 10 a.m. and will remain online through Wednesday, October 30, 2024, at 11:59 p.m.** To view the virtual public hearing, visit the following web address any time during the meeting times indicated above:

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person. The in-person option will be held in an open house format. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public hearing which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments.

For both the virtual public hearing and in-person option, members of the public may call 682-235-9845 to provide verbal testimony from 10 a.m. on Tuesday, October 15, 2024, through 11:59 pm on Wednesday, October 30, 2024. Formal written comments may also be provided by mail or email as explained below. All verbally provided testimony and timely written comments will be considered by TxDOT and included as part of the official record. Responses to verbally provided testimony and comments will be prepared by TxDOT, included as part of the hearing and project record, and made available online at [www.TxDOT.gov](http://www.TxDOT.gov) (keyword search “FM 1187 from Chisholm Trail Parkway to McCart Avenue”).

The proposed project would reconstruct and widen FM 1187 from west of Chisholm Trail Parkway to McCart Avenue in Tarrant County, TX, converting it from an existing two-lane roadway with a center turn lane to a four-lane roadway with a curbed center median to enhance safety, capacity, and connectivity. The proposed project will also facilitate the construction of additional lanes to be added in the future on a separate project. Bicycle and pedestrian improvements, including a 10-ft-wide shared-use path on both sides of the roadway, and curb and gutter to facilitate drainage are proposed.



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The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require approximately 49 acres of additional right of way and potentially displace seven non-residential structures. No residential displacements are proposed. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses.

Environmental documentation, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection by appointment only, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Fort Worth District Office located at 2501 S.W. Loop 820, Fort Worth, TX, 76133.

The virtual public hearing and in-person option will be conducted in English.
