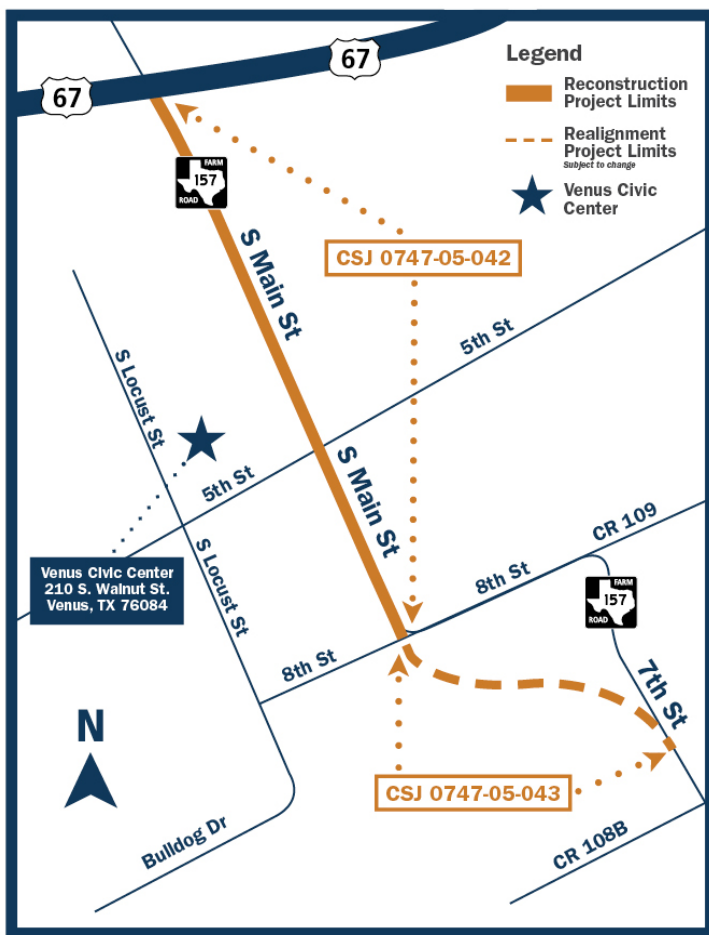




FM 157 –VENUS, TEXAS IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT PUBLIC MEETING

TxDOT is proposing improvements to FM 157 from US 67 to south of CR 109, in Johnson County, Texas.

Proposed improvements include:

- Reconstruction (CSJ 0747-05-042) of 0.5 miles of FM 157 from a two-lane roadway to a two-lane roadway with a 14-foot outside, shared-use lane in each direction, two-way left-turn lane, right-turn lanes, curb and gutter, sidewalks, driveways, and drainage improvements, from US 67 to 8th Street, and
- Realignment (CSJ 0747-05-043) of 0.3 miles of FM 157 on a new location south of 8th Street to south of CR 109, to include a two-lane roadway with a 14-foot outside, shared-use lane in each direction, two-way left-turn lane, right-turn lanes, curb and gutter, sidewalks, driveways, and drainage improvements.

TxDOT will host a meeting to present alternative designs and to receive public input on the proposed improvements. Maps and exhibits will be displayed at the public meeting. The meeting will be an open house format allowing interested members of the public to come and go at their convenience. Staff will be available to answer questions.

All interested persons are invited to attend this open house. The open house will be conducted in English. Persons interested in attending the public meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs, such as the need for an interpreter, are encouraged to contact Herman “Doane” Tarin, P.E. at (817) 399-4308 at least five (5) work days before the public meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.
