



**Virtual Public Meeting Notice with In-Person Option  
I-35W Segment 1**

**I-35W from north of I-20 to FM 3391/East Renfro Street and  
SH 174 from I-35W to south of Northwest Renfro Street  
CSJs: 0014-16-285, 0014-02-050, 0014-03-106, 0019-01-149  
Tarrant and Johnson Counties, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation is proposing improvements to Interstate (I) 35W from north of I-20 to Farm to Market Road (FM) 3391/East Renfro Street and State Highway (SH) 174 from I-35W to south of Northwest Renfro Street. The proposed project is approximately 10 miles long and extends through portions of the cities of Fort Worth and Burleson located within Tarrant and Johnson counties, Texas.

This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting with an in-person option to present the proposed project. The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The meeting will be available on **Thursday, October 26, 2023, at 8 a.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: <https://www.txdot.gov/projects/hearings-meetings/fort-worth/i35w-segment-1-102623.html> or by scanning the QR code on the top right-hand corner of this notice. Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until at least **Friday, November 10, 2023**. Please note that the presentation will not be available on the website until the time and date listed above. If you do not have internet access, you may call (817) 370-6852 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Central Time, Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. The in-person option will be held on **Thursday, October 26, 2023, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the DoubleTree by Hilton Fort Worth South Hotel & Conference Center located at 100 Altamesa Boulevard, Fort Worth, Texas, 76134.**

Proposed improvements include the reconstruction and widening of I-35W to five 12-foot-wide northbound lanes and six 12-foot-wide southbound lanes from I-20 to Everman Parkway, and five 12-foot-wide lanes in each direction from Everman Parkway to East Renfro Street. Frontage roads on I-35W and SH 174 would be reconstructed within the limits of the proposed project and would include 11-foot wide shared-use paths for pedestrians and bicycle accommodations.

Cross street connections would also be reconstructed and include bicycle/pedestrian accommodations. Improvements to I-20 include the widening of the north to east direct connector ramp to accommodate two lanes. No additional lanes would be added to I-20. Improvements to SH 174 include reconstructing the I-35W interchange and extending improvements along SH 174 with overpasses over Hillery Street and Renfro Street.

The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require approximately 17.1 acres of additional right of way (ROW) and potentially displace three commercial structures. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for ROW acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling Quenten Radford at (817) 370-6583.

The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands. The proposed project would involve an action in a floodplain.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection by appointment Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Fort Worth District Office, 2501 SW Loop 820, Fort Worth, Texas 76133. Project materials are also available online at: [www.TxDOT.gov](http://www.TxDOT.gov), or by scanning the QR code on the top right-hand corner of this notice. These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English and Spanish. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.
