The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting to present and discuss the proposed SH 183 (Northeast 28th Street) railroad underpass replacement in Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas. The purpose of the meeting is to present the proposed project to the public and offer an opportunity to discuss and make comments on the proposed improvements.

TxDOT proposes the replacement of the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) underpass on SH 183. The project limits are SH 183 from North Nichols Street to Decatur Avenue.

All interested persons are invited to attend this public meeting. The open house will be in English.
