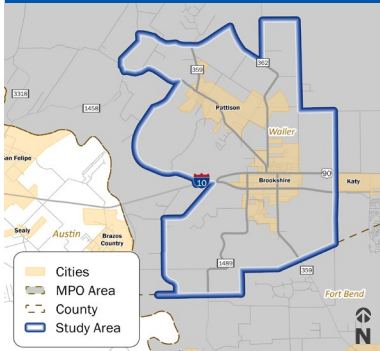

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is conducting a mobility study to address transportation challenges and support growth in the City of Brookshire, the City of Pattison, and their surrounding areas.

This study evaluates over 29 miles of key roadways, encompasses IH-10, US 90, and FM corridors (FM 359, FM 362, FM 1458, and FM 1489), to identify short-, medium-, and long-term solutions that improve safety, mobility, and sustainability while accommodating the region's residential and commercial growth. As Waller County experiences rapid growth, with Brookshire and Pattison projected to expand further, the study aims to ensure that transportation infrastructure evolves to meet the community's future needs.
