Virtual Public Hearing with In-Person Open House

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) invites you to a virtual public hearing with in-person open house. The purpose of this public hearing is to present the proposed project, engage with the community and gather feedback.

FM 1375 from FM 149 to Walker County Line

The proposed project would widen the existing travel lanes from 10-foot-wide to 12-foot-wide, add five-foot-wide outside shoulders and include one bridge replacement over Caney Creek and one bridge class culvert replacement over Green Branch along Farm-to-Market (FM) 1375 for approximately 6 miles.

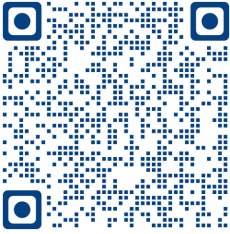
The proposed project would require the removal of approximately 5.4 acres of trees from the Sam Houston National Forest (SHNF) along FM 1375 within the boundaries of the Special Use Permit Area granted to TxDOT by the SHNF. The SHNF is protected under Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966. In accordance with Chapter 26 of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Code, this hearing is required to allow the public the opportunity to provide comments on the proposed project.

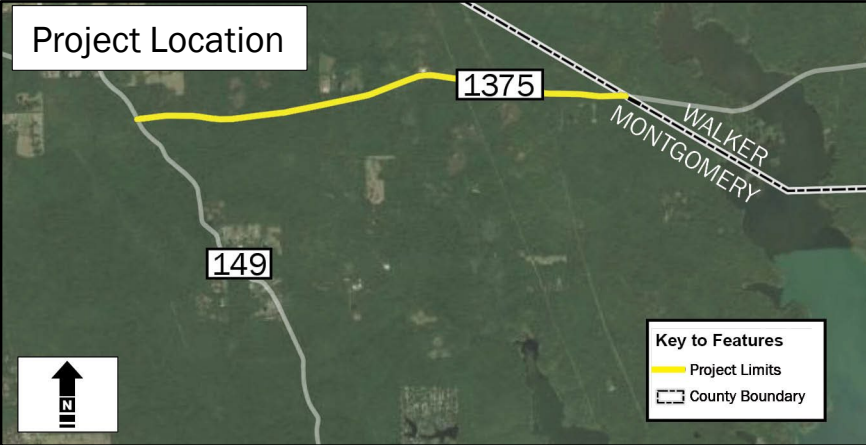
