



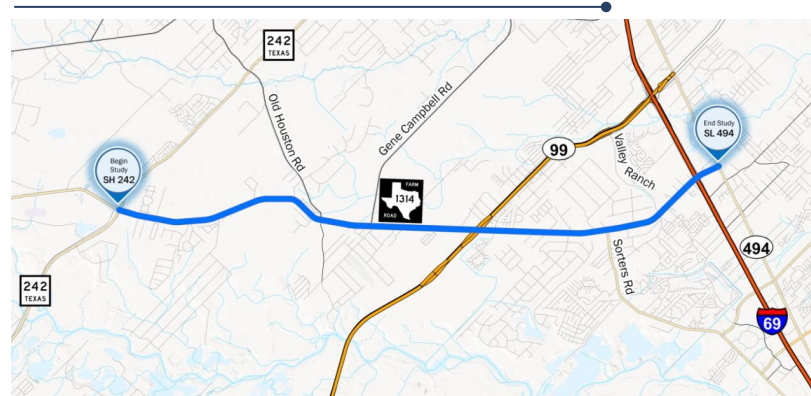
# FM 1314 Access Management Study (SH 242 to SL 494)

## What is this Project About?

TxDOT is conducting an Access Management Study for the 12-mile segment of FM 1314 from State Highway (SH) 242 to State Loop (SL) 494 in Montgomery County. Within these limits, FM 1314 is a north-south corridor that has experienced increasing traffic due to area growth in residential and commercial development.

The FM 1314 study segment carries approximately 20,500 to 36,400 vehicles per day. The crash risk increases gradually from the north to the south. The southern section has a crash rate significantly higher compared to similar roads across the state. The FM 1314 corridor has experienced increasing traffic due to growth in residential and commercial development. The corridor is a major thoroughfare and serves several communities. The roadway is divided by SH 99/Grand Parkway.

## Study Purpose

The purpose of FM 1314 Access Management Study is to provide vehicular access to land development in a manner that preserves the safety and efficiency of the transportation system. The FM 1314 study aims to identify transportation improvements to improve safety and mobility, traffic flow, reduce motorist delay, and support existing and future development.

### The proposed improvements may include:

- Optimization of signal timing/signal warrant studies
- Bicycle and pedestrian accommodations
- Add turn lanes at selected intersections
- Median treatment improvements
- Improved signage and pavement markings
- New signal warrant studies
- Bicycle and pedestrian shared use path
- Extend/include turn lanes
- Add raised medians
- Corridor widening
- Bicycle and pedestrian shared use sidepath
- Reconfigure intersections
- Access improvements
