**Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Open House  
Farm-to-Market (FM) 1314 Improvement Project  
From State Highway (SH) 105 to SH 242  
Control Section Job (CSJ): 1986-01-045  
Montgomery County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Houston District, is proposing improvements along Farm-to-Market (FM) 1314 from State Highway (SH) 105 to SH 242 in Montgomery County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an on-line virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person open house. **The virtual public meeting will be available starting on Tuesday, Jan. 23, 2024, at 5 p.m.** The virtual public meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. Please note that the presentation will not be available on the project website until the date and time listed above. If you do not have internet access, you may call (713) 802-5199 between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided mail or email as explained below.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person. In-person attendees will be able to view the same pre-recorded presentation as posted online, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions, and submit written comments. **The in-person open house will be held on Thursday, Jan. 25, 2024, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Wilkinson Elementary School, 2575 Ed Kharbat Drive, Conroe, Texas, 77301.**

The proposed project would include the reconstruction and widening of FM 1314 from a two lane (one lane in each direction) roadway to a four lane (two lanes in each direction) roadway with 12-foot-wide lanes. These improvements would include raised medians and 10-foot-wide shared use paths for bicycles and pedestrians on either side of the roadway. In addition, the project may include intersection improvements throughout the corridor. Innovative intersection strategies, such as roundabouts, continuous green-T intersections (CGTs), and restricted crossing U-turns (RCUTs), are being evaluated as alternatives to improve safety and operations.

The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require 55 acres of additional right-of-way (ROW) and potentially displace three residences and seven non-residential structures. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Act and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for ROW acquisition, may be obtained from Angela Leach-Jayroe, Right-of-Way Project Delivery Manager, by calling (713) 802-5753.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for review, by appointment only, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Houston District Office, 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007.
