## Proposed Project Description

TxDOT Houston District is proposing to raise the elevation of the existing I-10 main lanes above the floodplain of White Oak Bayou from Heights Blvd. to I-45. The proposed construction area would be approximately 1.8 miles in length. The project also includes the construction of a 21.7-acre detention pond located on the north side of I-10 between Taylor St. and Houston Ave. and would construct a 10-foot-wide shared use path on the north side of I-10 along White Oak Bayou between Studemont St. and I-45.

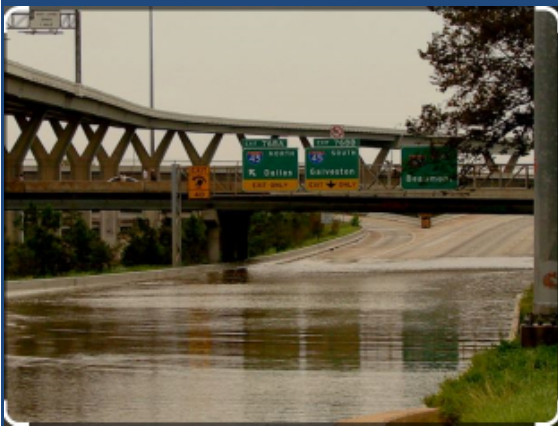

## Project Need:

- I-10 floods during major storm events
- During these events, high volumes of vehicular traffic, including police, fire and medical services are impacted

## Project Purpose:

- Reduce the risk of flooding of the I-10 facility and reduce occasions when the road would be impassable due to major rainfall events

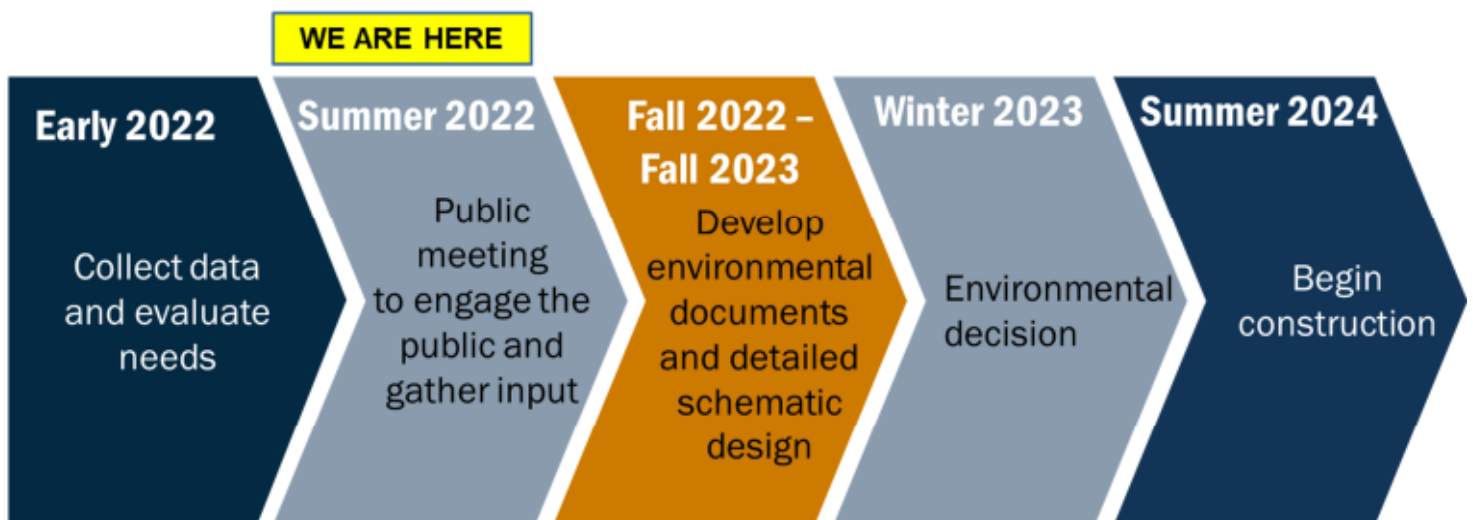

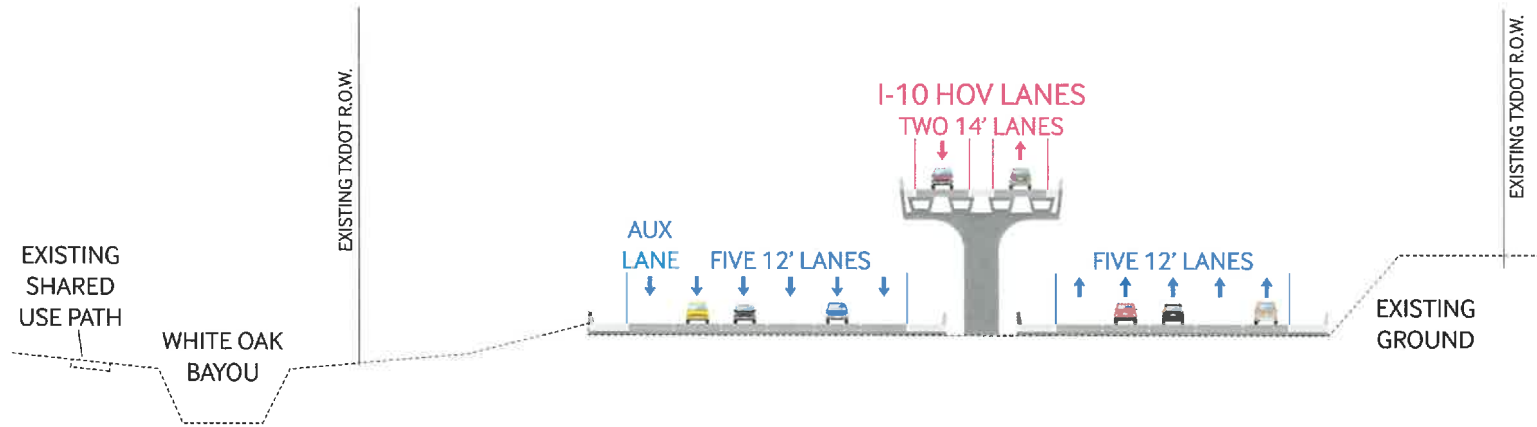
