TxDOT is holding a public meeting regarding proposed changes to

State Highway (SH) 105 from Mount Mariah Road to FM 149

Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Houston District, is proposing improvements along SH 105 from Mount Mariah Road to FM 149 in Montgomery County, Texas. The previously approved project includes widening the two-lane portion of SH 105 to four lanes from Mt. Mariah Road to SH 149. The original project went through public involvement and an environmental evaluation prior to the 2017 Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI), also known as Environmental Clearance. TxDOT is conducting a public meeting, with virtual and in-person options, in order to present the proposed design changes and receive public input. The proposed design changes include the addition of an access road and turnaround at the Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) railroad in Dobbin, and the addition of continuous sidewalks and shared use paths for pedestrians and bicyclists from Lone Star Parkway to Shepherd Street.
