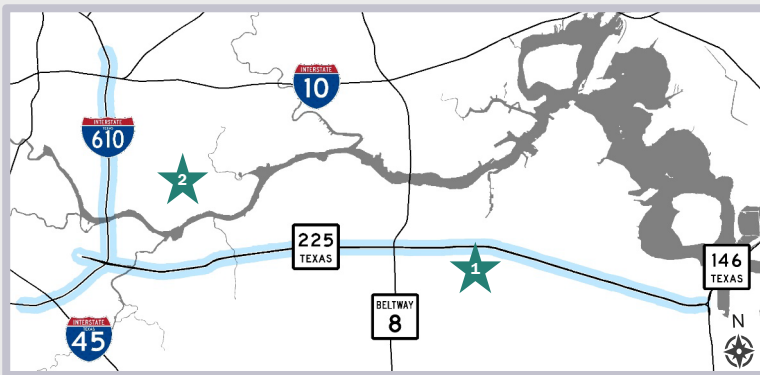
Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Open House Options

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) invites you to a virtual public meeting with two in-person open house options. TxDOT is conducting the State Highway (SH) 225 and Interstate (I)-610 East Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) Study. The purpose of the public meeting is to present transportation alternatives and receive public comments. An earlier set of public meetings was held in 2022 and public comments from those events along with stakeholder input was considered in the development of the alternatives.

SH 225 and I-610 East

A PEL study is a planning-level study that provides TxDOT the opportunity to gather information that informs various elements of the transportation decision-making process. This particular PEL is being conducted along two existing roadways that comprise one study area. The SH 225 portion is approximately 14 miles long and includes the entire SH 225 corridor, starting west of the I-610 East interchange, and ending at SH 146. The I-610 East portion is approximately 7.5 miles long, beginning at Telephone Road, proceeding over the Ship Channel Bridge, and ending at Gellhorn Drive.

As provided for by 23 CFR 450.212, 23 CFR 450.318, and Appendix A to 23 CFR Part 450, the results or decisions of this Planning and Environmental Linkages Study may be incorporated into or used as part of the review of one or more projects under the National Environmental Policy Act, which would be carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 USC 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated Dec. 9, 2019, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.



You are invited to participate in the PEL Study by reviewing the materials online or in-person at the open house and submitting feedback to the Study Team.

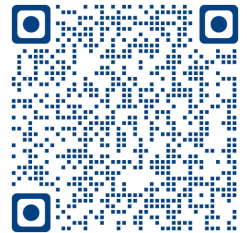
