

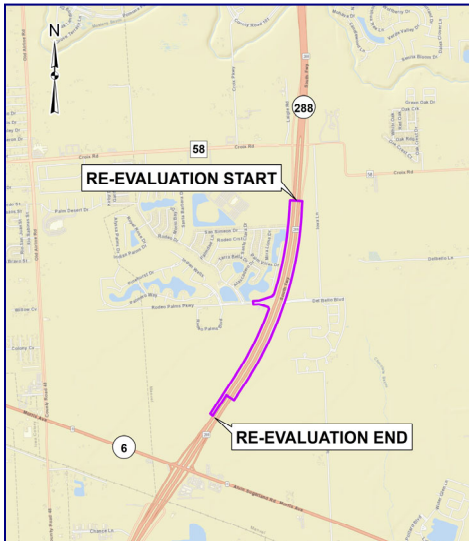

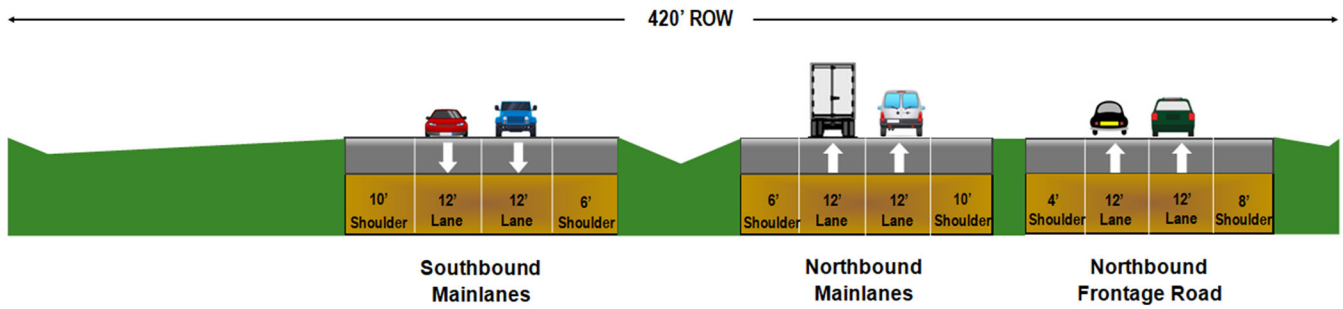

Project History

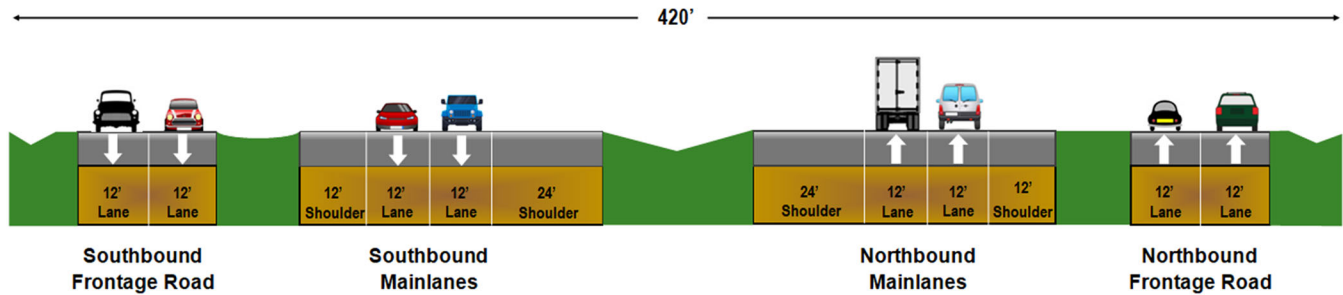
The original Federal Highway Administration (FHWA)-approved project proposed general improvements to SH 288 from US 59 near downtown Houston to County Road 60 for a distance of approximately 26 miles. This original project went through public involvement and environmental evaluation prior to the 2013 FONSI and portions have been constructed. This virtual public meeting addresses proposed design changes to the environmentally cleared project. Proposed Project Description

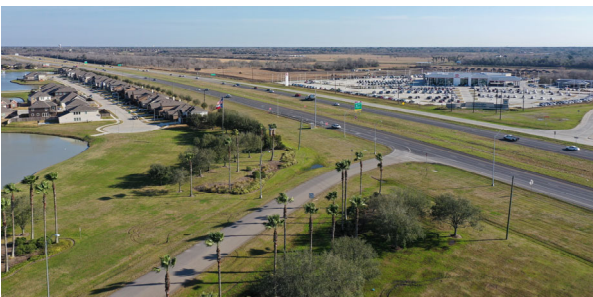
The proposed design changes consist of the construction of a two-lane southbound frontage road from north of Rodeo Palms Parkway to north of SH 6 and construction of four stormwater detention ponds. The proposed additions would occur within the existing TxDOT right-of-way (ROW), and would not result in any displacements.

Why are these design changes proposed?

The purpose of the design changes is to connect the southbound frontage road along SH 288 between Rodeo Palms Parkway and SH 6, and to provide detention for the original project.

Next Steps

- TxDOT environmental decision
- Final design
- Let date: August 2022
- Anticipated construction to begin in 2022
- Construction time is approximately 2.5 years
