



**Notice and Opportunity to Comment
Grand Parkway SH 99 Segment B1
I 45 to North of FM 2403**

**Control Section Jobs (CSJs): 3510-01-001, 3510-02-001, 3510-02-003, 3510-01-003
Brazoria and Galveston Counties, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Houston District is proposing design changes to the approved alignment of Grand Parkway State Highway (SH) 99 from Farm-to-Market (FM) 2403 to Interstate (I) 45 in Brazoria and Galveston Counties, Texas. Modifications have been made to the design that was presented at the Virtual Public Meeting made available on Tuesday, Oct. 10, 2023, and the in-person Public Meetings held on Thursday, Oct. 12, 2023, and Tuesday, Oct. 17, 2023. Proposed design changes were made in response to public comments and refined drainage analysis. The proposed changes include shift(s) in stormwater detention pond locations, shift in the right-of-way (ROW) 30 to 60 feet north between SH 35 and I-45, additional ROW along Clifford Street, and inclusion of ramps to and from FM 1462 to provide access to Alvin Community College. This Notice is Affording an Opportunity to Comment (NOC) as part of the environmental review process for this project. If you are a property owner, you are receiving this notice because records indicate that you own property that (1) would be acquired (in part or in whole) for this project, or (2) is adjacent to the project. This notice and opportunity to comment is also being provided to affected local governments and public officials.

A Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) and the Record of Decision (ROD) were approved in 2016 for the construction of a four-lane, controlled-access toll road with discontinuous frontage roads on new location within a 400-foot-wide ROW. Project limits for the approved project are from I-45 to SH 288 in Brazoria and Galveston Counties. Since the release of the FEIS and ROD design, SH 99 Segment B was split into two segments, B1 and B2. Changes are being proposed between I-45 and FM 2403 (Segment B-1) that would require an environmental re-evaluation.

Although additional ROW would be required, no additional residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for ROW acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT Houston District office by calling (713) 802-5606.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and proposed design changes, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for review by appointment Monday through Friday between the hours of 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Please contact Gabriel Adame, TxDOT Public Engagement Coordinator, at (713) 802-5199 or by email at Gabriel.Adame@txdot.gov to schedule an appointment.
