**Southern Waller County Projects Community Workshop**  
**Waller County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is hosting a community workshop seeking input on various proposed roadway improvements in southern Waller County, Texas.

The purpose of the community workshop is to engage with the public and gather feedback on proposed projects in Waller County. We welcome your input on transportation-related issues you face in your community. TxDOT will consider all feedback received in developing projects to meet the needs identified by public input. The roadways being considered for improvements include:

- **Farm-to-Market (FM) 1489:** From I-10 to FM 359  
(Control Section Job (CSJ): 1418-01-013)
- **FM 2855:** From FM 529 to I-10  
(CSJ: 2898-01-013)
- **FM 359:** From FM 1458 to FM 362  
(CSJ: 0543-01-068)
- **FM 362:** From FM 529 to FM 359  
(CSJ: 0523-02-053)

This notice advises the public that the project team will be conducting the workshop in both the virtual (online) and in-person formats. The project materials will be available online starting on Friday, December 13, by 5 p.m. The virtual workshop will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components.
