FM 179 ROADWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT

TxDOT is proposing to rehabilitate the FM 179 roadway from US 62 to FM 1585 in Lubbock County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will conduct a virtual public meeting with an in-person option on the proposed project. The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components.

The proposed FM 179 project extends approximately 1.8 miles from US 62 to FM 1585. The improvements consist of reconstructing and widening the existing roadway to add a two-way left turn bay, perform structure replacements, and the installation of a signal and safety lighting.

The proposed project would involve an action in a floodplain and address drainage conditions in relation to the roadway widening by replacing drainage structures.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Lubbock District Headquarters, 135 Slaton Rd., Lubbock, TX 79404.

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
