



## Notice of Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option

### **FM 835 Bridge Replacement Project** **Crossing the North Fork Double Mountain Fork Brazos River** **CSJ: 0933-01-044 | Lubbock County, Texas**

TxDOT is proposing to replace the FM 835 Bridge in Lubbock County, Texas that crosses the North Fork Double Mountain Fork Brazos River. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a virtual public meeting with an in-person option on the proposed project. The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by 5 p.m. CT on Thursday, Jan. 22, 2026, and will remain online for at least 15 days. If you do not have internet access, you may leave a voicemail for the TxDOT Projects Team anytime at 806-748-4450. You may also leave questions or comments during the project development process. Formal comments may also be provided by mail or email as explained below.

The proposed FM 835 bridge replacement project crosses the North Fork Double Mountain Fork Brazos River. The improvements consist of replacing the bridge structure and improving the intersection of Olive Street at FM 835. The proposed project, subject to final design considerations does not require right-of-way acquisitions or displacements.

The proposed project would involve an action in a floodplain and addresses drainage conditions in relation to the bridge replacement project.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a. m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Lubbock District Headquarters, 135 Slaton Rd., Lubbock, TX 79404.

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document

translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting, please contact TxDOT Lubbock District Public Information Officer Dianah Coronado, at 806-748-4472, no later than 4 p.m. CT, Monday, Jan. 19, 2026. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.
