



## Notice of Virtual Public Meeting 2023-2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program Available for Viewing on Friday, May 27, 2022, at 1 p.m. Lubbock District

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will be conducting a virtual public meeting for the proposed 2023-2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP) for the TxDOT Lubbock District.

**The virtual public meeting pre-recorded presentation and meeting materials will be available for viewing on Friday, May 27, 2022, at 1 pm.** This virtual meeting format (no in-person meeting) includes a pre-recorded video presentation and comment opportunity. The presentation will include both audio and visual components.

The purpose of this virtual public meeting is to receive comments on the proposed projects of the 2023-2026 Rural TIP for the TxDOT Lubbock District. The Lubbock District includes Bailey, Castro, Cochran, Crosby, Dawson, Floyd, Gaines, Garza, Hale, Hockley, Lamb, Lubbock, Lynn, Parmer, Swisher, Terry, and Yoakum counties. The Rural TIP includes all regionally significant projects to be funded within a TxDOT district during the next four years, including those eligible for funding. As such, these meetings offer the public an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed priorities. A project in the Rural TIP is a project coming to your community. The Rural TIP is the first step on the road to producing a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

The Rural TIP meeting is being held pursuant to *Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102*, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program. Presentation materials will show how the Rural TIP operates along with associated/prioritized projects.
