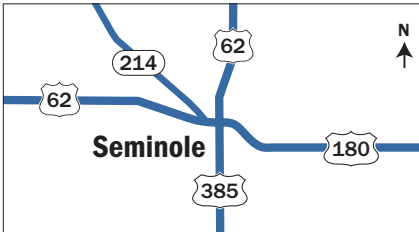

TxDOT cordially invites you to attend a virtual public meeting regarding the proposed improvements to US 62/US 385 in Seminole, TX.

TxDOT will host a live virtual public meeting at 6 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 11, 2020. Three proposed project options to improve mobility and safety through Seminole will be presented and discussed, and will be followed by an opportunity to ask questions.
