



# US 259 WIDENING

## FROM SH 204 TO RUSK COUNTY LINE

Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is hosting a virtual public meeting with an in-person option regarding the widening of US 259 from SH 204 to the Rusk County line. This event is being held to display the proposed improvements, explain to the public where TxDOT is in the project development process, answer questions, and gather local citizen input. The virtual public meeting will consist of a pre-recorded presentation, display project exhibits and other information, and provide instructions to submit comments. The in-person option will include the same information available in the virtual option and have TxDOT staff present to answer questions.
