**Finding of No Significant Impact**

**HACHAR-REUTINGER ROAD**  
**From FM 1472 to I-35 West Side Frontage Road**

**Webb County, Texas**

This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed Hachar-Reuthinger Road project, and that the final EA is available for public review. The proposed project would construct a new location four lane divided roadway from FM 1472 to I-35 West Frontage Road in Webb County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final Environmental Assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Laredo District Office, 1817 Bob Bullock Loop, Laredo, TX 78043.
