Laredo Outer Loop Feasibility Study

From the I-35/SH 255 interchange to the vicinity of the proposed fifth bridge crossing, near Rio Bravo, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Laredo District is conducting a feasibility study on the proposed Outer Loop Project in Webb County from the Interstate Highway 35 (I-35)/State Highway (SH) 255 (Camino Colombia Road) interchange to the vicinity of the proposed fifth bridge crossing, near Rio Bravo, Texas in Webb County. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting public meetings in an open house format on the proposed project. The purpose of the meetings is to present the proposed alignments and to receive comments from the public. There will not be a formal presentation; however, staff will be available for one-on-one discussions, as well as to assist the public. Displays will be available for viewing. The public meetings will be held on the locations and times listed below.

The Outer Loop aims to provide additional capacity and accommodate future growth in Laredo by providing a new high-capacity connection along the east side of Laredo. The proposed Outer Loop will extend approximately 45 miles, from the I-35/SH 255 interchange to the vicinity of the proposed fifth bridge crossing, near Rio Bravo. The ultimate cross section considered for this roadway will be a six-lane freeway (three lanes in each direction) with one-way two-lane frontage roads on each side. The proposed alignments extend north to south to the east side of the Laredo city boundary (see map included).

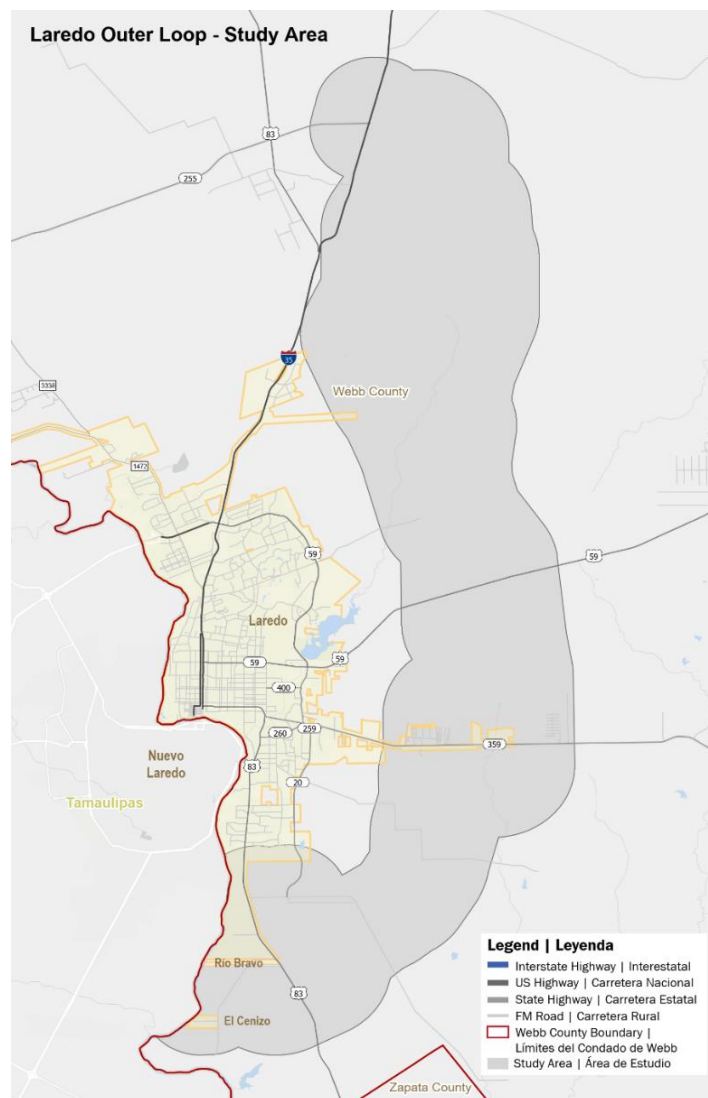
