TxDOT PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT TRAINING COURSES 2021-2022

The TPP Public Involvement Section is excited to announce upcoming public involvement training, which includes a **NEW** advanced-level public involvement planning course. Class size is limited, so sign up soon. TxDOT staff can sign up by searching in PeopleSoft for the courses listed below. Public involvement training is highly recommended for district, division, area, or maintenance office employees whose roles include public involvement, and for consultants who work on public involvement projects.

Effective Public Involvement (EPI) 100: EPI 100, formerly "OPI 100," is the PI Section team's flagship introductory public involvement course and provides TxDOT staff and consultants with foundational strategies and resources for effective public involvement.

NEW! Effective Public Involvement (EPI) 200: EPI 200 is an advanced-level training that provides a deeper understanding of internal public involvement planning. EPI 100 is a prerequisite for EPI 200, and participants should already understand basic public involvement strategies.
