



## Notice of Virtual Public Meeting Texas Department of Transportation 2025 – 2028 Rural Transportation Improvement Program Odessa District

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) – Odessa District will conduct an online virtual public meeting for the 2025 – 2028 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The purpose of this meeting is to provide information and receive comments on which transportation projects may be coming to your area. The Odessa District includes Andrews, Crane, Ector, Loving, Martin, Midland, Pecos, Reeves, Terrell, Upton, Ward, and Winkler counties. The Rural TIP includes all added capacity and regionally significant projects to be funded within a TxDOT District during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding. As such, this meeting offers the public an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed priorities. The Rural TIP is the first step on the road to producing a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

The virtual public meeting will consist of a pre-recorded presentation discussing projects in Andrews, Crane, Ector, Loving, Martin, Midland, Pecos, Reeves, Terrell, Upton, Ward, and Winkler counties. The presentation will be available at the time and date indicated below:
