BS 158 (Andrews Hwy)
From Loop 250 to Tarleton Street

Midland County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the City of Midland are proposing to improve Business State Highway (BS) 158 from Loop 250 to Tarleton Street in Midland County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. If you are a property owner, you are receiving this notice because records indicate that your property is adjacent to the project. This notice and opportunity to comment is also being provided to affected local governments and public officials.

The proposed project would consist of widening and restriping BS 158 to add an additional travel lane in each direction, from Loop 250 to Midland Drive, and an additional eastbound travel lane from Midland Drive to Tarleton Street. An eastbound right turn lane would be added at the intersection of Midland Drive.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the Odessa District Office, 3901 E. Highway 80, Odessa, Texas, 79761, 432-498-4645. Project materials are also available online at www.TxDOT.gov, keyword search "BS 158."

The project materials are written in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
