



Notice and Opportunity to Comment
Interstate 20
From East of FM 1208 to East of SH 349
CSJs: 0005-15-093
Midland County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to reconstruct and widen Interstate 20 (I- 20) from east of Farm to Market (FM) 1208 to east of State Highway (SH) 349 in Midland County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. If you are a property owner, you are receiving this notice because records indicate that you own property that (1) would be acquired (in part or in whole) for this project, or (2) is adjacent to the project.

Improvements would include adding main lanes, constructing new interchanges, reconfiguring existing interchanges and ramps, intersection improvements, and converting frontage roads from two-way operation to one-way operation west of Business I-20. The proposed project would require approximately 26.3 acres of additional right-of-way. The total length of proposed project is approximately 12.8 miles.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT Odessa District office by calling (432) 498-4645.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Odessa District office, 3901 East Highway 80, Odessa, TX 79761, and (432) 498-4697.

The project materials are written in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
