



VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING WITH IN-PERSON OPTION PECOS EAST RELIEF ROUTE

The Texas Department of Transportation cordially invites you to attend a virtual public meeting with an in-person option regarding the Pecos East Relief Route Study. This proposed relief route would help long-term mobility, connectivity and safety needs on US 285 for local and through traffic.

The proposed roadway would generally consist of a new divided highway including two mainlanes in each direction and two one-way frontage roads in each direction separated by a lowered grassy median. The project would also include new interchanges at major intersections and shared use paths. The overall project length would be approximately 10 miles.

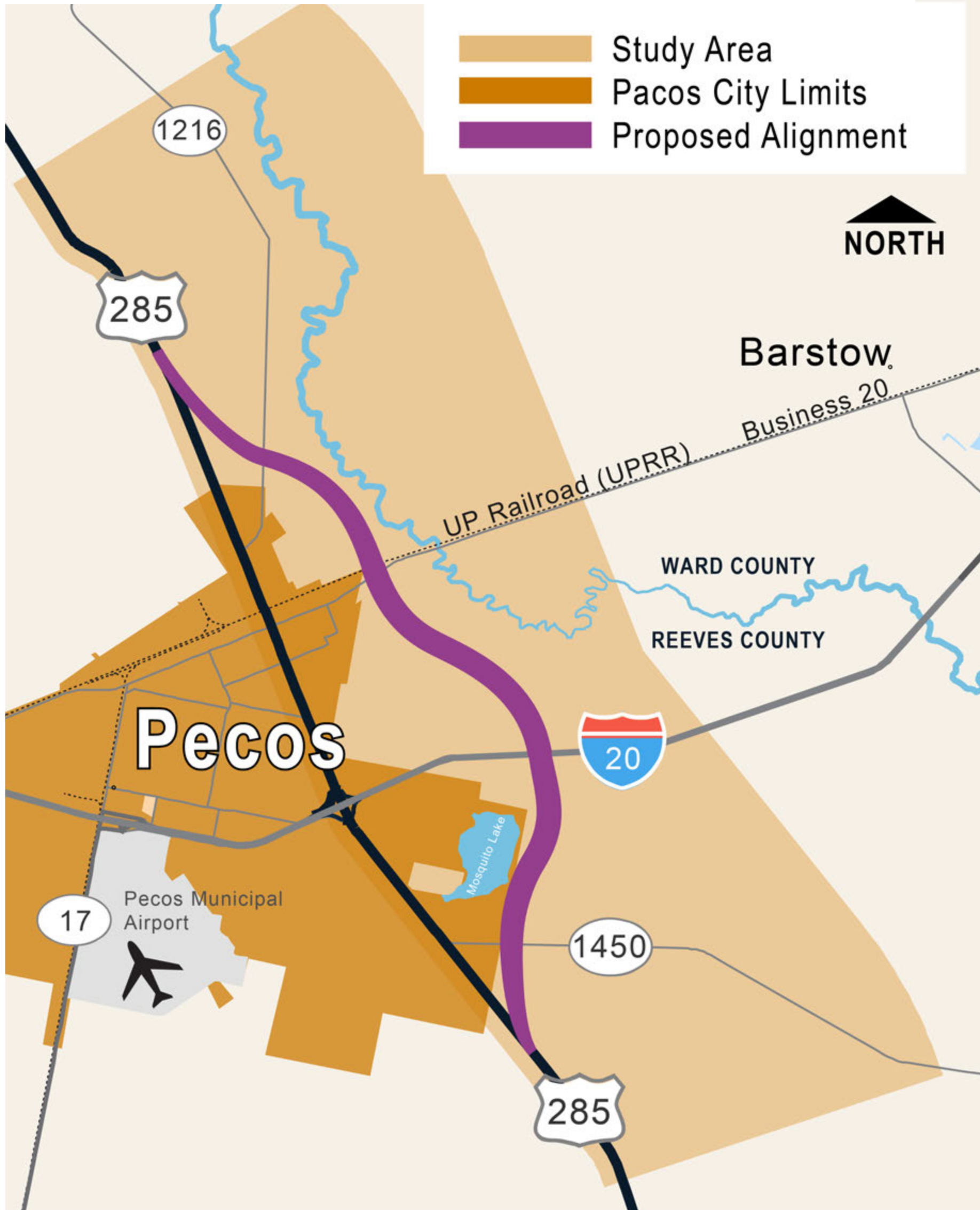
