Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option
Pecos East Relief Route
From US 285 North of Pecos to US 285 South of Pecos
CSJ: 0906-18-016
Reeves County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Odessa District is proposing to construct a relief route around the east side of the Town of Pecos City in Reeves County, Texas, from US 285 north of Pecos to US 285 south of Pecos. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a virtual public meeting with an in-person option.

The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation that will be posted online by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, June 04, 2024. To access the virtual public meeting, visit www.TxDOT.gov and in the "Search TxDOT" box in the upper-right hand corner, enter "Pecos East Relief Route" at the date and time indicated above. Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation and project materials will remain available for viewing online through Thursday, June 20, 2024. Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants and leave written comments.

The in-person option will be held Tuesday, June 04, 2024, from 5 to 7 p.m., at the Reeves County Civic Center, 1500 S. Cedar St., Pecos, TX 79772.

The proposed roadway would generally consist of a new divided highway including two mainlanes in each direction and two one-way frontage roads in each direction separated by a lowered grassy median. The project would also include new interchanges at major intersections and shared use paths. The overall project length would be approximately 10 miles.

The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional right of way and potentially displace no residential structures and two non-residential structures. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners can be obtained from by calling Rochelle Juette, Public Information Specialist, 281-529-4172. The proposed project could involve construction in wetlands and may involve action in a floodplain.

The project materials are written in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
