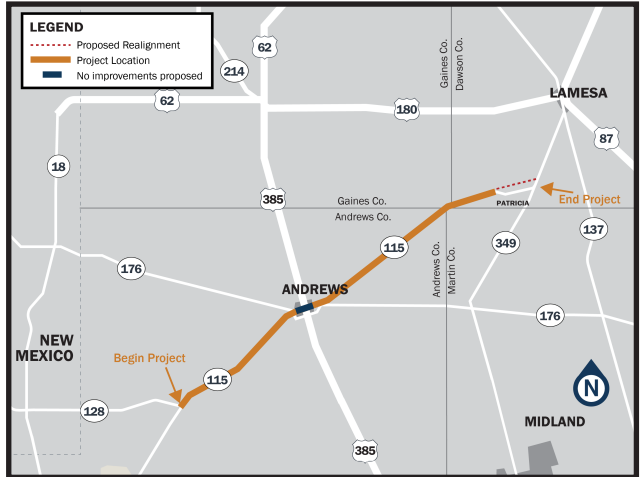
The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is holding a virtual public meeting to review proposed improvements to SH 115 from SH 128 (Andrews County) to SH 349 (Lamesa County). The proposed project length is approximately 55 miles in length.

Proposed improvements to SH 115 include:

- Widening to a four-lane divided highway, with two lanes in each direction.
- Adding a non-paved depressed median to provide a safe separation buffer between opposing directions of traffic.
- Realigning a 5-mile segment of SH 115 on the north end of the project, near Patricia.
