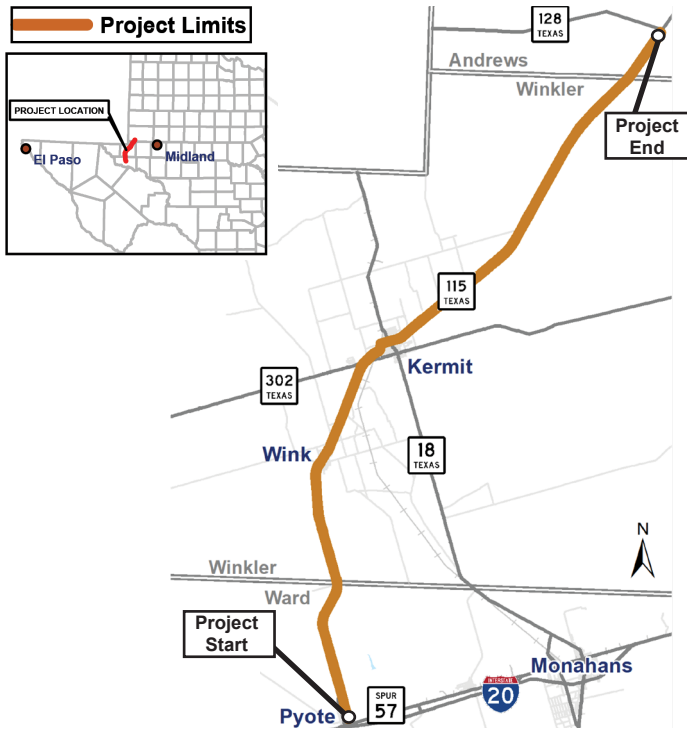

### Proposed Project:

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing improvements on SH 115 starting at Spur 57 in Pyote and extending north for 49 miles through the cities of Wink and Kermit, then eventually ending at SH 128, about 3.4 miles past the Winkler/Andrews county line. Proposed improvements would include widening to a four-lane divided highway with two lanes in each direction and a depressed median.
