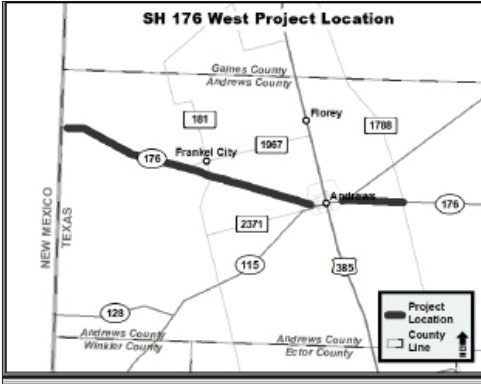

TxDOT cordially invites you to attend the second virtual public meeting regarding the proposed SH 176 West project.

The goal of this project is to improve safety and mobility along the SH 176 corridor. The project would include widening the existing SH 176 in Andrews County to a four-lane divided highway from NW 9999 to FM 1788, a length of approximately 40 miles. No widening or other improvements are anticipated within the city of Andrews.

TxDOT has scheduled a virtual public meeting starting at 5 p.m., Thursday, Aug. 4, 2022. It will be available through Friday, Aug. 19, 2022.
