SH 176 West
From New Mexico state line to FM 1788

Andrews County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to improve SH 176 from the New Mexico state line to FM 1788 east of the city of Andrews in Andrews County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a virtual public meeting on the proposed project. The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be available on Wednesday, Oct. 20, 2021 at 5 p.m. To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: www.TxDOT.gov and in the "Search TxDOT" box in the upper right-hand corner, enter "SH 176 West."

Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until at least Friday, Nov. 5, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call (432) 200-8502 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided by mail or email as explained below.

The proposed project would include widening the existing SH 176 in Andrews County from a two-lane undivided highway to a four-lane divided highway with two lanes in each direction, a center median or barrier, inside and outside shoulders and median openings, as needed. The proposed project is approximately 40 miles. No improvements through the city of Andrews are anticipated.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained by calling (432) 200-8502.

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting, please contact the project team at (432) 200-8502 no later than 4 p.m. CT, Thursday, Oct. 14, 2021. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.
