The proposed SH 18 North project would begin just south of the New Mexico state line extending to Loop 464 south of I-20, approximately 36.2 miles, and would include:

- Widening to a four-lane divided highway with two lanes in each direction; and
- A center median or barrier and turn lanes throughout the entire length of the project.

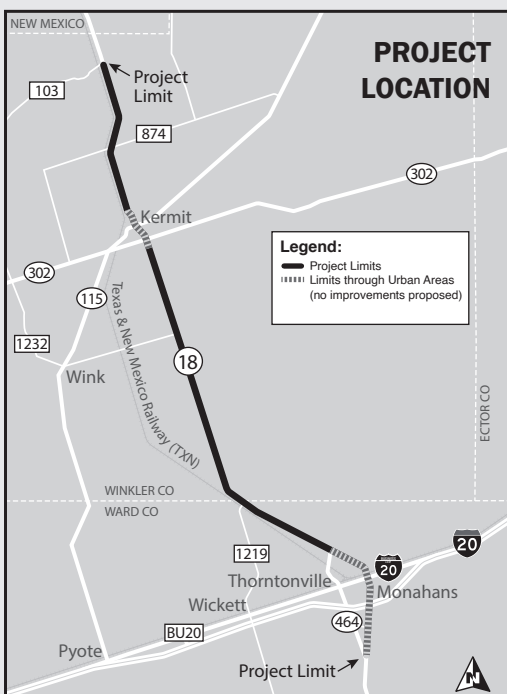
