Join us for a Virtual Public Meeting to learn more about proposed improvements for the SH 18 South Project.

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen State Highway 18 (SH 18) from Loop 464 in Monahans to Business Interstate 10 (BI-10) in Fort Stockton in Ward and Pecos counties, Texas.

The SH 18 South project corridor is approximately 46 miles in length. The proposed improvements to SH 18 would include widening to a four-lane divided highway with two lanes in each direction and a center median consisting of an open ditch or turn lane.
