Opportunity for a Public Hearing
SH 302 from east of CR 313 to FM 2019
CSJ: 0463-06-035, etc.
Winkler and Ector counties, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Odessa District is proposing to widen SH 302 from east of CR 313 to FM 2019 in Winkler and Ector counties, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT is affording an opportunity for a public hearing on the proposed project.

TxDOT is proposing to widen SH 302 within the project limits from a two-lane highway with passing lanes to a four-lane divided highway, with two travel lanes in each direction, a center median, inside and outside shoulders and median openings, as needed. The existing right of way varies from approximately 120 to 150 feet wide. The proposed expansion would increase the right-of-way width to 220 feet.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT Odessa District Office by calling 432-498-4645.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Odessa District Office, 3901 E. Hwy. 80, Odessa, Texas 79761. Project materials are also available online at www.TxDOT.gov, keyword search "SH 302 NAOPH."

The project materials are written in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. Hwy. 80, Odessa, Texas 79761, or by email to Gabriel.Ramirez@txdot.gov. **All hearing requests and comments must be received on or before Monday, February 9, 2026.** A hearing will be held if ten or more individuals submit timely written requests for a hearing, or if an agency with jurisdiction over the project submits a timely written request for a hearing that is supported by reasons why a hearing will be helpful. Responses to comments received will be available online at TxDOT.gov once they have been prepared.
