



Notice of a Virtual Public Meeting

Loop 338 from E Yukon Road to US 385 N CSJ: 2224-01-117 | Ector County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Odessa District is proposing to widen Loop 338 from E Yukon Road to US 385 N in Ector County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by 5 p.m. Thursday, July 27, 2023.** To access the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: www.TxDOT.gov, keyword search "Loop 338 from E Yukon Road to US 385 N".

Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above through Friday, Aug. 11, 2023. If you do not have internet access, you may call (432) 498-4645 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided by mail or email, as explained below. A mailed copy of the virtual public meeting materials can be obtained by calling (210) 864-0049.

TxDOT is proposing to widen Loop 338 within the project limits from a four-lane divided highway to a four-lane freeway with frontage roads in each direction, for a distance of approximately five miles. In addition, a 10-foot shared-use path would be constructed to accommodate both bicyclists and pedestrians located on the outside of the frontage roads. The project would also consist of constructing overpasses at Grandview Avenue, 87th Street, and 100th Street, along with entrance and exit ramps, and auxiliary lanes.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT Odessa District Office by calling (432) 498-4645.

Information regarding the proposed project is on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Odessa District Office, 3901 E. Highway 80, Odessa, Texas 79761. Project materials are also available online at www.TxDOT.gov, keyword search "Loop 338 from E Yukon Road to US 385 N."

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
