

# SH 289 from FM 120 to End of State Maintenance (Elks Boulevard)

Roadway Reconstruction and Widening

## Project Overview

### Project Limits

From Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 120 to End of State Maintenance at Elks Boulevard in Grayson County in the city of Pottsboro, Texas.

**Project CSJs:** 0091-01-052; 0202-08-067

**Project Length:** 7.01 miles

**Right of Way:** The proposed project would require new right of way.

### Project Purpose

- Improve safety
- Improve regional mobility and connectivity
- Address roadway deficiencies

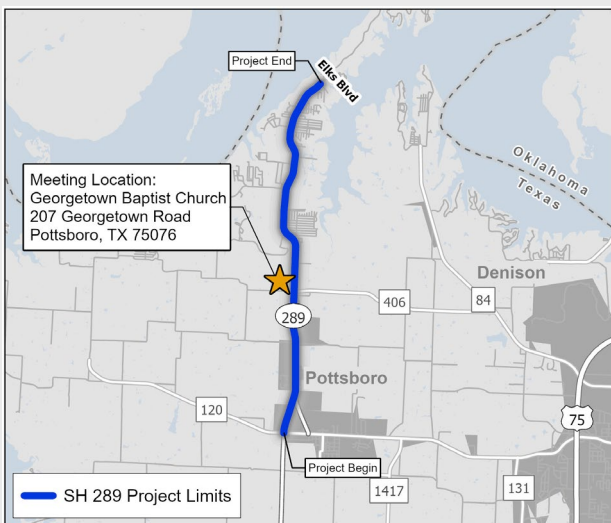
### Project Description

The proposed improvements to SH 289 include the reconstruction and widening of the roadway from a 2-lane rural roadway to a 5-lane roadway containing two 12-foot wide travel lanes in each direction with a 16-foot wide continuous two-way left turn (TWLT) lane from FM 120 in Pottsboro to End of State Maintenance at Elks Boulevard for approximately 7.01 miles. Additional improvements include an 11-foot wide shared-use path on the east side and a six-foot wide sidewalk on the west side of SH 289.

### Project Considerations

- Upgrade highway to current design standards
- Improve regional mobility
- Add highway capacity for increasing traffic volumes
- Accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians
- Minimize right of way and environmental impacts
- Minimize utility impact where feasible
