



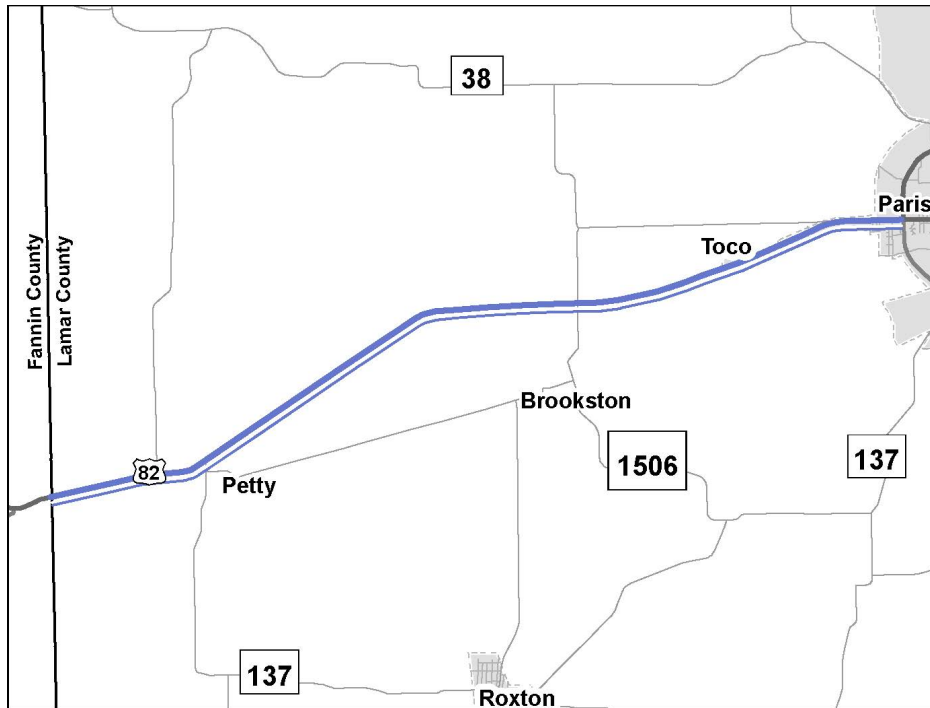

## US 82 VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING

From Fannin County Line to Loop 286 West of Paris, Texas  
Lamar County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Paris District is proposing to improve US Highway (US) 82 from the Fannin County Line to Loop 286 West of Paris, Texas in Lamar County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a second online virtual public meeting on the proposed project.

The proposed improvements to US 82 include widening US 82 from a 2-lane highway to a 4-lane divided highway for a distance of approximately 16 miles. The proposed roadway from the Fannin County line to County Road (CR) 23900 west of Toco includes two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide outside shoulder, and a 68-foot-wide depressed median. From CR 23900 to Loop 286, the roadway includes two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide outside shoulder and a 16-foot-wide continuous left turn lane. Within the City of Paris limits, a 5-foot-wide sidewalk would be provided on the south side of US 82.
