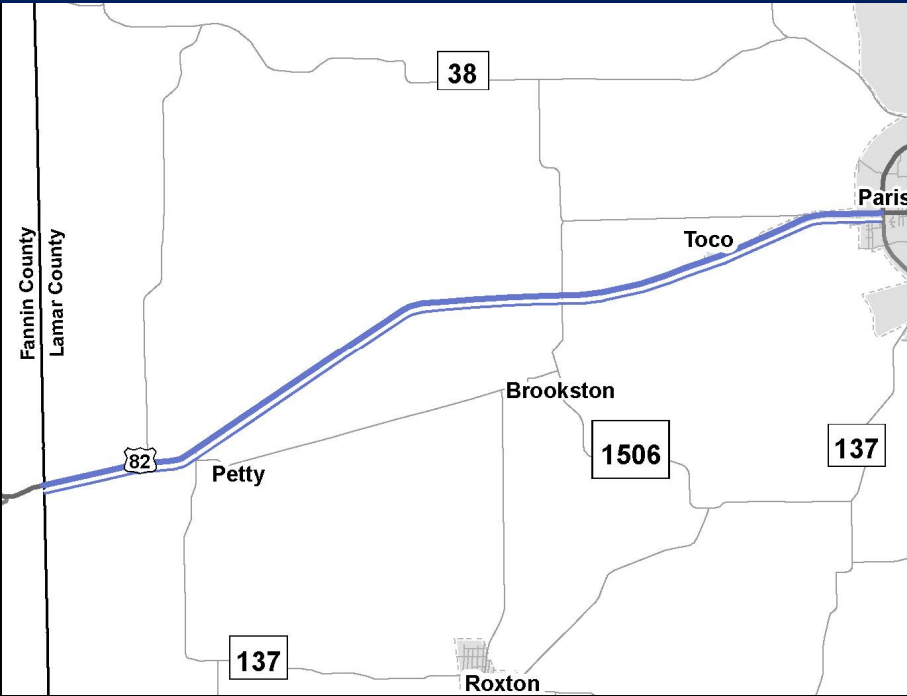

From Fannin County Line to Loop 286 West of Paris, Texas



Limits: From Fannin County Line to Loop 286 West of Paris, Texas in Lamar County

Project Length: 16 miles

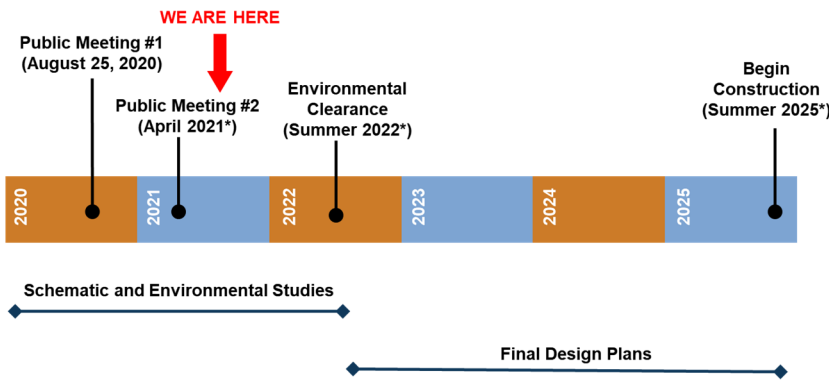
Schedule and funding for construction have been identified for this project.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed improvements to US 82 include the following:

- Widen US 82 from a two-lane highway to a four-lane divided highway for a distance of approximately 16 miles.
- The proposed roadway from the Fannin County line to County Road (CR) 23900 west of Toco includes two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide outside shoulder, and a 68-foot-wide depressed median.
- From CR 23900 to Loop 286, the roadway includes two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide outside shoulder and a 16-foot-wide continuous left turn lane.
- Within the City of Paris limits, a 5-foot-wide sidewalk would be provided on the south side of US 82.
