



Notice and Opportunity to Comment

FM 755 REHAB SUPER 2

From FM 1017 to Starr/Brooks County Line

CSJs: 1103-02-014

STARR County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to reconstruct and add a passing lanes (Super 2) to FM 755 from FM 1017 to the Starr/Brooks County line in Starr County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. If you are a property owner, you are receiving this notice because records indicate that you own property that (1) would be acquired (in part or in whole) for this project, or (2) is adjacent to the project.

This project is 7.949 miles long beginning at FM 1017 and continuing north on FM 755 to the Brooks/Starr county line, where it passes through the Town of Santa Elena. The proposed project facility will have the existing footprint increased from 40 feet to 44 feet. The extra 4 feet consists of 2 feet added on each side of the road. There will be 1.6 acres of new ROW. The new ROW is at each of the 2 curve sections, which are being realigned to contain a larger radius. The project adds passing lanes at 3 locations and then otherwise, remain a two-lane roadway, one for north and two for southbound. There will be two 12 foot travel lanes both going northbound and southbound with a 0 foot to 14 foot center lane that alternates.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling Ramon Jimenez, Jr., Right of Way Supervisor at 956-702-6287.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at Pharr District Office 600 W Interstate 2 Pharr, Texas 78577. Project materials are also available online at www.txdot.gov search keyword "FM 755 Rehab Super 2"

The project materials are written in English.
